Progress update:

- The slides are nearly complete and will be sent to the volunteer reviewers for suggestions on improvements and additional information, specifically looking for the perspective from non-pain physicians
- There are 26 attendees. Plan to raise the cap to 30 to allow for those on the waitlist
- Plan to add detailed speaker notes for continuity at future Pain Academies

Concerns discussed include:

- Defining a partnership agreement for monitoring content and revenue sharing
- Need for strict content review, presenter qualification checks, and Society membership requirements

There was a motion to submit the Pathway proposal to the Legal, Business and Ethics Committee for review before Board approval, Seconded, Approved.
