- Additional details discussed:
 1. Proposal to reduce the subscription price to \$180 (instead of \$185) to make it more attractive.
 2. Guarantee at least nine Grand Rounds per year to account for Annual Meeting month and possible cancellations.
 3. Subscription applies to the upcoming calendar year only.
 4. Archive content will not be included to avoid CME cost loss.
 5. Marketing strategy to highlight value.
 6. The Committee will create a catchy name for the subscription.

There was a motion to set the subscription price at \$180, Seconded, Approved.

Action Item- Steve Harvey, Sabrina Segal, Ibrahim Alsherief, and Amy Baxmann to finalize written proposal and recirculate to the Committee before the next meeting, in preparation for a vote.

IV. New Business

- **Discuss the idea of a TMS Educational Content Task Force**
 - Proposal to shift from content creation to content curation, meaning, identify and potentially endorse high-quality external educational resources and post on the CTMSS website instead of solely focusing on creating our own content.
 - Discussion points:
 1. Organize curated materials by topic.
 2. Consider placement behind or in front of paywall.
 3. Clarify whether to include free vs. paid resources.
 4. Operational feasibility and oversight/maintenance emphasized.

Action Item- Continue discussion at the next meeting and consider starting with a small pilot effort.

- **International Travel Award/Scholarship program**
 - Concept presented by Dr. Brown:
 1. Establish a travel award/scholarship for those who wish to attend the Annual Meeting and live in lower-income countries.
 - Discussion points:
 1. Funding likely to come from FACTMS starting with the 2027 Annual Meeting.

2. Education Committee to assist in the application evaluation process.
3. Need for:
 - a. Application process.
 - b. Clear qualifying parameters.
 - c. Scoring rubric.
 - d. Transparent and fair criteria.
4. Possible joint task force between the Education and M&O Committees.
5. Target implementation for 2027 Annual Meeting.

There was a motion to form an International Travel Award Task Force to develop an application process, qualifying parameters, and scoring rubric in partnership with the M&O Committee, Seconded, Approved.

Action Item- Education co-chairs to reach out to M&O co-chairs about partnership.

Action Item- Establish the task force at the next committee meeting.

- **Member Survey on Grand Rounds Topics**
 - The Research Committee is organizing a single Society-wide survey at the Annual Meeting.
 - Each committee may submit questions to be included in the survey.

Action Item- Develop Grand Rounds survey questions at the next meeting.

V. Task Force and Sub-Committee Updates

- **Slide deck for Basic Brain Networks Task Force**
 - Close to finalizing the first draft.
 - Approximately 54 slides.
- **Slide Deck for TMS Treaters Task Force**
 - Close to finalizing the first draft.
 - Approximately 104 slides.
 - Considering splitting into two courses.
- **Grand Rounds Sub-Committee**
 - The Grand Rounds schedule is full until May.
 - Reminder that Steve Harvey will step down from Grand Rounds in June and a replacement needs to be identified.

Action Item- Steve Harvey to extend an invitation to Andres Cerins to present TMS treatment angel paper at the July or August Grand Rounds.

- **Slide deck translation Task Force**
 - AI Spanish translation in progress.
 - Will conduct an expert review upon receipt.
- **Slide deck for MA/PhD level therapists**
 - Project remains on hold.
- **Psychiatry resident survey**
 - Currently around 45 responses.
 - Targeting 70-80 responses.
 - Submitted an abstract for the Annual Meeting to promote further distribution.
