**I. Call to Order**

M. Dokucu called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM ET.

**II. Approval of Minutes**

*Motion to approve the minutes from the August 8, September 2, and September 23 committee meetings duly made, seconded, and approved.*

**III. Discussion Items:**

M. Dokucu informed the committee that 4 speakers have responded positively to the informal invites, Leanne Williams, Alvaro Pascual-Leone, Saydra Wilson, and Joseph Taylor. Formal invites have been sent to the speakers as well.

The committee then discussed inviting a speaker to speak on TMS and fibromyalgia, specifically Daniel Ciampi de Andrade. The committee briefly discussed the recent publication on the topic.

*Motion for Mohamed Abdelghani to invite Daniel Ciampi de Andrade as a plenary speaker on TMS and fibromyalgia duly made, seconded, and approved.*

The committee then discussed other potential topics. Members expressed interest in a symposium around safety and TMS, specifically around migraines, syncope, seizures, and panic attacks. The committee discussed ways to collect data from CTMSS membership around this topic and whether the topic should be included in the 2026 Annual Meeting. The discussion highlighted challenges in gathering reliable data on rare events like seizures and suggested focusing on prevention and management strategies instead. Concerns were expressed with these events being so rare, whether a talk on this would be interesting for attendees.

Alternative ideas included the effects of TMS on suicide ideation and alternative targets for neuropsychiatric disorders. Members agreed that alternative targets would be an interesting topic for the meeting. The committee also discussed stroke rehabilitation with TMS. It was noted that breakout tracks could be created based on what individuals are using TMS to treat, such as neurology/stroke, pain, and neuropsychiatric disorders. The committee agreed to wait for symposia proposals before deciding breakout session content, noting the committee may need to fill remaining slots with focused presentations on non-psychiatric indications like TMS for stroke or pain.

The discussion also touched on including content about TMS for wellness, with some members raising concerns about its controversial nature and potential impact on CTMSS's mission. Members agreed that the topic would work better on a panel rather than an individual talk. Harold Sackeim was suggested as someone that could either speak on the panel or provide ideas for other speakers to invite. The group discussed organizing a panel on the use of TMS for cognitive enhancement. It was noted that while TDCS and TACS have been used for cognitive enhancement, TMS has not been applied to cognitively standard individuals.

The committee also discussed revisiting the idea of a session on artificial intelligence, whether it be using it with TMS or other components of TMS, such as insurance letters.

The committee agreed to discuss more potential speakers and topics at the next meeting.
